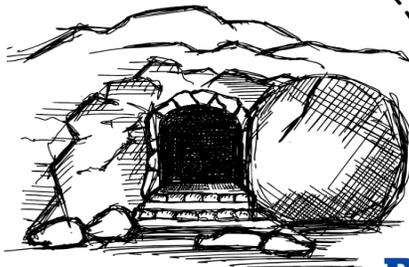

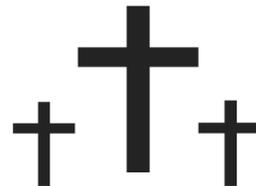

The Road to Resurrection: A Journey of Prayer & Fasting

Dear Church Family,

We are excited to invite you on our “Road to Resurrection” journey through prayer and fasting—a sacred time to draw closer to God as we prepare to celebrate Christ’s resurrection.

The Journey

Our congregation-wide fast begins **Saturday, March 7**, and concludes on **Resurrection Sunday, April 5**. During these 30 days, we invite you to join us in seeking God’s presence with renewed intentionality.

The Invitation

Perhaps God is calling you to step beyond your comfort zone—to try something new or seek Him like never before. When we quiet ourselves, we position our hearts to hear His voice. There are treasures He longs to reveal, wisdom He desires to impart, and breakthroughs awaiting those who pursue Him, making this journey deeply meaningful for your spiritual growth.

Scripture reminds us in **Matthew 17:21**: “However, this kind does not go out except by prayer and fasting.”

Some circumstances in our lives will only shift through dedicated prayer and fasting. Would you risk missing what God has specifically for you simply because you didn't participate?

Understanding Fasting

Fasting is the purposeful abstinence from something pleasurable to redirect our focus from flesh to spirit. This spiritual discipline has been practiced throughout biblical history as a powerful response to challenging situations, circumstances, and needs.

As **Joel 1:14** instructs: "Consecrate a fast, call a sacred assembly; gather the elders and all the inhabitants of the land into the house of the Lord your God and cry out to the Lord."

While fasting traditionally involves abstaining from food, your fast may take many forms:

- Specific types of food (sugar, meat, etc.)
- Social media or entertainment
- Other regular pleasures or activities

Important Guidelines

- Choose a fast limited to this designated time period (1 Corinthians 7:5)
- Some may prefer sunup to sundown fasting
- **Important health note:** Please consult your physician before beginning any fast from food or medication
- Remember that everyone can participate—if you cannot fast from food for health reasons, consider other meaningful



sacrifices, like digital or activity fasts, that help you draw closer to God, ensuring inclusivity and comfort for all.

We've provided this guide to help you prepare your heart and mind. Let us approach these 30 days with expectation, knowing that as we draw near to God, He promises to draw near to us.

In anticipation of what God will do.

THREE TYPES OF FASTING

1. Normal Fast

What it involves: Abstaining from all forms of food while drinking only water.

Biblical examples:

- Jesus in the wilderness (Luke 4:1-2, Matthew 4:2-3)
- Abraham's servant, while on his mission (Genesis 24:33)

2. Absolute Fast (Total Fast)

What it involves: Abstaining from both food and water completely.

Important caution: This type of fast requires extreme care and should be practiced for no more than 3 days, as it can be physically dangerous if extended.

Biblical examples:

- Esther and the Jews before she approached the king (Esther 4:16)
- Paul, after his encounter with Christ (Acts 9:9)

3. Partial Fast



What it involves: Selectively abstaining from certain foods or following specific eating patterns.

Common approaches:

- **Daniel Fast:** Consuming only fruits, vegetables, whole grains, legumes, nuts, seeds, and water
- **Selective Restriction:** Abstaining from specific categories like meats, sweets, or carbohydrates
- **Intermittent Fasting:** Restricting eating to certain time windows

Biblical example:

- Daniel's refusal of royal food and wine (Daniel 1:12-15)
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Things to Fast From Besides Food

Digital/Technology Fasts

1. **Social Media** - Abstaining from platforms like Instagram, Facebook, Twitter, TikTok
2. **Screen Time** - Limiting or eliminating TV, video games, and streaming services
3. **Smartphone Usage** - Reducing phone time or setting specific no-phone hours
4. **Email/Work Communications** - Setting boundaries on checking work messages

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5. **Digital News** - Taking a break from news consumption

Consumption Fasts

1. **Shopping** - No non-essential purchases for a set period
2. **Fast Fashion** - Avoiding clothing purchases
3. **Amazon/Online Shopping** - Specifically cutting out impulse online buys
4. **Dining Out** - Cooking at home instead of restaurant meals
5. **Subscription Services** - Pausing or canceling recurring services

Food and Beverage Related

1. **Meat** - Practicing vegetarianism temporarily
2. **Caffeine** - Giving up coffee, tea, or energy drinks
3. **Sugar** - Eliminating added sugars and sweets
4. **Processed Foods** - Focusing on whole, unprocessed foods only

Lifestyle Fasts

1. **Complaining** - Consciously avoiding negative talk
2. **Gossip** - Refraining from speaking about others
3. **Multitasking** - Focusing on one activity at a time
4. **Rushing** - Intentionally slowing down daily activities
5. **Noise** - Creating periods of silence in your day

THE SPIRITUAL BENEFITS OF FASTING

Divine Reward

“When you fast, do not look somber as the hypocrites do... But when you fast, put oil on your head and wash your face, so that it will not be obvious to others that you are fasting, but only to your unseen Father; and your Father, who sees what is done in secret, will reward you.” (Matthew 6:16-18)

Spiritual Humility

“I humbled myself with fasting.” (Psalm 35:13)

Spiritual Breakthrough

“Go, gather together all the Jews... and fast for me. Do not eat or drink for three days, night or day.” (Esther 4:16)

Liberation and Healing

“Then your light will break forth like the dawn, and your healing will quickly appear.” (Isaiah 58:8)

Divine Guidance

“While they were worshiping the Lord and fasting, the Holy Spirit said, ‘Set apart for me Barnabas and Saul.’” (Acts 13:2)



Answered Prayer

“So we fasted and petitioned our God about this, and he answered our prayer.” (Ezra 8:23-24)

HEALTH & SAFETY GUIDELINES

Consult Your Physician — Everyone should consult their physician before beginning any fast, especially:

- Those under medical care
- People taking medications
- Individuals with existing health conditions
- Anyone with a history of eating disorders

Breaking Your Fast — When your designated fasting period ends, transition gradually:

- Do not rush back to solid foods
- Begin with small portions and simple foods
- Allow your body time to readjust
- Serious side effects can occur from breaking a fast too quickly

Spiritual Focus — When cravings arise:

- Recognize these as the flesh opposing the spirit

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- Use these moments as triggers for prayer
 - Redirect your attention to praising God
 - Meditate on Scripture during times of temptation

Pure Intentions — Fast as unto the Lord:

- Present your fast as a form of worship
 - Offer it as a sacrifice to God (Zechariah 7:5)
 - Let it be a time of seeking His presence (Acts 13:2)
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THE ROAD TO RESURRECTION FASTING

Options:

- **DANIEL FAST:** Fruits, vegetables, whole grains, legumes, nuts, seeds, water
- **INTERMITTENT FASTING:** Eating window from 12 PM-8 PM only
- **LIQUID FAST:** Consume only liquids until 3 PM
- **ONE MEAL A DAY:** Single well-balanced meal
- **Fast from 6 AM to 6 PM**
- **Or as recommended by your healthcare provider.**

- **Strangers:** People estranged from the church
