



My dear Faith Family,

I invite you to (honestly) say the first things that come into your mind when I say a word. Ready, set, (no cheating) go - the word is HOME. What words or images came to your mind? I tried this on a few people and their answers varied from their current home (and the longing to be there more) all the way back to the home they grew up in as a child. Some shared that home is not a place but rather the people around them who make up their sense of being 'home'. Others shared that they are on a journey and don't know where home is yet.

The youngest replied, 'Mama'. The oldest replied, 'Heaven'. Interesting, right?

Let me share some of my answers. I have been humming the "Sloop John B" by the Beach Boys, "Homeward Bound" by Simon and Garfunkel", and from camp days, "Gee, Mom, I want to go Home." Since I am married to a rowdy CCR fan I am also singing, "Put a Candle in the Window, cause I feel I've got to move. Though I'm going, going, I'll be coming home soon, long as I can see the Light.' Of course, The Wizard of Oz springs to mind as Dorothy clicks her red ruby slippers and says, 'There's No Place Like Home'. I also remember the scene in the movie Homeward Bound where an aged Golden Retriever named Shadow comes up over the knoll consumed with concern for his boy Peter. I always cry at the joy of their embrace as Shadow, too old and frail to do it, makes it HOME at last.

Have you ever had to leave a home you loved? Have you ever longed to have all your loved ones under one roof? To be home together? Don't we all at some point? **HOME** is a word that carries more emotion, conflict, joy, and longing than any other word I can name. This is not surprising since we have within us, planted by God, a longing for eternity, to be safely **home**. In Eccles. 3:11 we hear, "He (God) has made everything beautiful for its time: moreover, He has put a sense of past and future into their minds, yet they cannot find out what God has done from the beginning to the end." We remember what has been and we long for what is yet to be. Each of us began in a 'home' and we will each experience a variety of what constitutes home for us during our lifetime. We long for the fullness of 'being home'.

In the beginning God created a glorious Garden for our first parents to call HOME, the Garden of Eden, with the best thing of all being His presence with them in the Garden. Sin saw them cast out of that perfect **HOME**, yet they received God's gracious promise to bring them **HOME** one day through the Messiah He would send. (Gen.3:15). Jesus, that Messiah, whose birth we shall celebrate this month, clearly promises in John 14:2b-3a, "I go to prepare a place for you... I will come again and take you to myself." Jesus IS our HOME. We sing a hymn called, "Journey's End" which ends with these beautiful words of welcome, "You journeyed long and hard, Now everlasting joy is yours, My child, you're home at last!" This Advent and Christmas season we will be journeying through a series entitled, 'Coming HOME for Christmas - Advent in Isaiah. Our weekly themes are "Far from HOME; There's NO Place like HOME; A HOME Unbroken; A Light that Leads us HOME; and HOME at Last".



I invite your prayers for Eddie and his family; Tommy and his family; for their life-long friendship and for all who serve in The Skit Guys ministry. This is a very hard time for all of them. Tommy Woodward will be moving forward with a new ministry entitled 231 Collective, and most of their materials will be transferred, along with all church and personal subscriptions. The ways in which Eddie & Tommy have shared the Gospel and hope of Christ throughout the years in skits, videos, movies, etc. will continue to share the Good News of our Saviour Who forgives sinners and restores them.

As your Pastor I wanted to share this news with you. We can be very hurt when a person in leadership or the public sphere behaves in ways God's Word does not condone. It often comes as a feeling of betrayal, and our young people especially struggle to understand. I encourage conversation if this happens to you or your family.
