Pastor's Note

Did you know that '**November**' comes from the Latin word, '**novem**', which means nine? Me neither. Why nine when it is the eleventh month of the year? Simply because the Gregorian calendar only had ten months and so November was the ninth month. Once January and February were added to the calendar November became the eleventh month. And to add in a wee bit of gory history: November was the month of heavy animal sacrifice with every village reeking of the scent of blood as people stocked up on food for the winter. These sacrifices ensured they could live through the hard, cold days – meat brought hope for the always uncertain future. This

got me thinking about the month of November and what it brings each year, most notably Remembrance Day. The eleventh month of the year marks the phenomenal sacrifices that were made by so many so that there could be a future with freedom and hope. In John 15:12 we hear Jesus say, "No one has greater love than this, to lay down one's life for one's friends." The cross still speaks to our world today showing what LOVE is, the very body and blood of Christ, the only innocent person to ever live, willingly and obediently laid down for the sins of the world! This, Is, Love.

November seems anticlimactic as the excitement of Thanksgiving celebrations, fall festivals, and All Hallow's Eve end, and Christmas is far away. After the beauty of All Saint's Sunday, where again we remember those who have gone before us in faith and trust, what does one do in November? As a kid I dreaded November as a dull, dark, long month to be gone through so December could begin. I now have a granddaughter born in this month and so it has a new meaning of joy for me, but I am not alone in the desire to push through this month. Look around and you will find there is a definite rush on the part of people to move immediately to Christmas with trees set up earlier each year, lights ablaze and parties galore. I wonder if this isn't motivated by our deep desire to push away the dark and seek warmth and light?

God assures us in Ecclesiastes 3 that there is 'a time for every purpose under heaven' and I believe the deepening darkness and stillness of shorter November days combined with reflection upon the cost of sacrifice and love speak both softly and significantly with God's deep purpose. We often sing a hymn entitled, 'Still, my soul be still' which encourages reflection and hope. 'Still, my soul be still, and do not fear though winds of change may rage tomorrow. God is at your side, no longer dread the fires of unexpected sorrow... Still, my soul be still, do not be moved by lesser lights and fleeting shadows. Hold onto His ways with shield of faith against temptation's flaming arrows.' There is both a need and a time for reflection, for stillness and for remembrance. It is said that one needs the dark to experience light. In John 1:5 we hear that "the Light shines in the darkness and the darkness did not overcome it." Reflection on darkness and light brings the reminder that we are sinners so easily drawn to 'lesser lights' and 'fleeting shadows'. It also brings the joyous hope that is ours in Jesus Christ who is the Light that the darkness cannot overcome. Jesus is the One who has laid down His life for His friends. Jesus is the One who calls me and you – friend! Our weary souls need November. I invite you to rest in the stillness of this month and to hear the promise of God's Word which is our constant hope in the always uncertain future ahead. Join me in proclaiming, "God, You are my God, and I will trust in You and not be shaken. Lord of peace renew a steadfast spirit within me, to rest in You alone." As November begins I shall be praying for the replenishing and strengthening of our faith that our souls may be at peace, PM
