What an awesome opportunity to participate and serve at the North Macedonia Children's Summer Camp with our Missionary Jennifer Moore and to witness her ministry in action. What a blessing to experience and fellowship with North Macedonian United Methodists at a village church in Monospitovo!

This Rummage Sale will go towards buying a new floor cleaner for the church and school supplies.

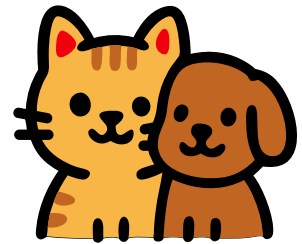
