Jane: Opening Prayer:

We come together this morning to pray the rosary. As we remember the evil which led to Jesus' unjust death, we focus on resisting the normalization of evil in our time. We strive to live out our faith to the fullest. Prayer can help expose evil for what it really is. Our faith, love and courage in the Divine Center of the Universe grabs the attention of all who witness it. This is possible for all of us, right here and right now, one moment at a time. We pray together for these intentions.

Voice 1: First Intention (Mystery): *Prayer for our planet Earth.*

Breath of Life, we ask for the very survival of our planet earth. Our previous vision, set in prayer was: "as it was in the beginning, is now and ever shall be".

¹ This version of the rosary was implemented in January of 2025 to help parishioners deal with their experience of helplessness, sorrow and grief with respect to the policies the U.S. was taking under leaders claiming to be Christian. Via sought assistance from Jackie Davis, who struggled with the language of the traditional rosary, in its preparation. Davis composed the introductory prayers for the Mysteries based on the sources she cites. Her voice and style of praying the rosary helped shape its slow, soulful pace.

Via's personal relationship with Mary was fraught with challenges as she struggled with traditional theology and language for Mary. Over many years, Via has sought language, based in contemporary Catholic theology, for the most basic Catholic prayers, including the Hail Mary and the Glory Be. The idea to connect the traditional rosary with contemporary events by centering the Mysteries on the critical issues of our/one's time is hers. One strand of contemporary Catholic theology recognizes Mary as the maternal face of Holy Mystery. As such, her role extends beyond intercession to reality of Holy Mystery itself. The rendering of the Hail Mary and Glory Be is Via's, as is the idea of "personalizing" the Hail Mary. For example, instead of "Pray for us now and at the hour of our death", which often remains meaningful, one might also pray "Be with (name), the child of my womb....".

"The Lord's Prayer" or "The Prayer Jesus Taught Us", as Joseph Stewart of San Diego, CA taught her to call it, is rendered by an unknown writer. It has been used in the parish founded by Via and Rod Stephens for more than a decade and put to music by Rus Kosits. Efforts to discover the writer have been unsuccessful. Via welcomes any information a reader may have and would gladly acknowledge their rendering were it known.

Because this rosary is meant to be prayed slowly, each word spoken with conscious attention, we pray 5 Hail Mary's instead of 10. This enables the rosary to be prayed, collectively, in a half hour, approximately the same period of time the traditional version is usually prayed.

We have learned from science that there is no forever; creation is always in process, the Earth will not always exist. Had we acknowledged this sooner, perhaps our Earth would not be on the path to extinction.

Wrap us in your power of intention and action, that we may protect and heal our planet's precious life from the depths of the oceans to the heights of our skies. We pray...**Amen**

² Hail Mary (Basic Version): Hail Mary, Grace Incarnate, maternal face of Holy Mystery, blessed are you among women and blessed is Jesus, the child of your womb. Holy Mary, truly our sister, Mother of the Cosmos, (be with us now and at the hour of our death) (altered depending on the intention of the individual offering the prayer).

³ Contemporizing ancient prayers requires attention to the prayer's rhythm or cadence. The more similar the rhythm to the traditional rhythm, the more easily the praying person adjusts to the new words, especially if they have no knowledge of the New Cosmology/ contemporary Catholic theology. While a feminist approach favors the use of Sophia, some may find the rhythm, or cadence, favors the use of Holy since Sophia involves 3 syllables and Holy only 2 syllables. Please choose Sophia or Holy as you prefer.

Holy Life, we ask for wisdom to see the damage being done to our democracy by those who would mislead, deflect, disrupt, and deny the humanity of others.

We ask for the courage to learn, to witness, to speak up; to take daily actions as caring citizens, and to protect the right of all to vote and be heard.

Help us connect to our fellow citizens and commit to their well-being.

We pray for all peaceful protesters, immigrants and citizens, especially those who have died in an effort to protect their immigrant neighbors and friends.

We also pray for the people of Iran, that our country will withdraw from that conflict, and end our war against the Iranian people. We pray for a just end to the war in the Ukraine, which has suffered massive displacement of its people, thousands of deaths and destruction of its cities and infrastructure. We pray that the perceived need for Hamas and terrorist violence in the Middle East will end. We pray, that Israel will seek an end to its current war and a lasting and just solution to violence in the Middle East. We pray for the people of Gaza, especially the thousands of women and children, who have died in a conflict they did not choose. We pray for an end to that devastation made possible by U.S. weaponry. We pray for the countries in Africa suffering genocide and displacement of their populations. Holy Mystery, we pray for peace on our planet Earth, the whole Earth, not just our “corners” of the earth. ***Amen.***

Voice 1: **Third Intention: Prayer for All Immigrants everywhere and, especially, for those currently living in our country, those subjected to ICE incarceration, and those along our borders.**

Divine Love, we ask your blessing on, and entrust to You, all those who have made the journey to another land, enduring fear, uncertainty and danger to reach a place of safety and hope.

We ask you to accompany them through the dangers that chase them from their home countries, the dangers they encounter on the journey, the dangers in the camps along the border and the dangers to those who are incarcerated and abused by our own government.

We ask your tenderness and protection for them; and, in caring for all immigrants, may we seek a world where no one is forced to leave their home, where all can live in freedom, dignity and peace.

Finally, we pray for the more than 50 people who have died this in the custody of our government since January 2025...May they find a permanent home in the womb of your Holy Love. **Amen.**

Consoling Presence, we ask you for sanctuary for those in the LGBTQIA+ community, and for women, who feel fear due to many national protections previously and recently put in place - and now withdrawn- as well as the threat of others to be retracted. We especially ask for sanctuary for, and acceptance of, trans people, for recognition of their value and goodness.

We ask for sanctuary for all those who ever wondered if they were truly made in the image and likeness of God because of their sexual orientation or gender identity.

We ask this blessing of knowing that we all are fearfully and wonderfully made in God's image. **Amen.**
