Qualified Charitable Distributions

Bonita Park is eligible to receive Qualified Charitable Distributions (QCDs)! The IRS maximum distribution per IRA owner to one or more charities in a calendar year changes regularly. Please consult your IRA trustee or administrator for qualifying amounts. A QCD is a transfer of funds from your IRA custodian made payable directly to a qualified charity. Amounts distributed as a QCD can be counted toward satisfying your Required Minimum Distribution (RMD) for the year but is excluded from your taxable income. You must be at least 70½ years old the first time you request a QCD. If you process a distribution prior to reaching age 70½, the distribution will be treated as taxable income. If you are at least 70½ years old, own an IRA, and donate to charity, QCDs may make sense for you; consult a tax advisor regarding your specific situation.



Matching Gifts

Bonita Park has recently received a very generous matching gift of **\$100,000!!** This gift will be used to help with the most pressing needs on the grounds. Several of these needs can be found at the Events Center. The roof is in great need of being replaced to prevent damage to the inside of the facility.



Bonita Park has also received a matching gift of **\$5,000** for funding updates to the Events Center alarm system as well as updating office phones and internet systems that are able to work with Starlink Satellite systems.

Received to Date: \$21,150

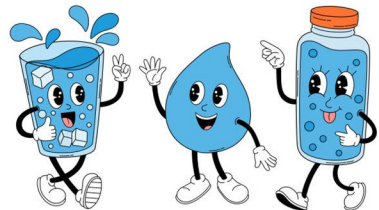

Commercial RO System for Morris Center

Bonita Park's water is known to be quite harsh. It affects everything from the taste of ice, beverages and foods, to the longevity of machinery such as the ice machine and dishwasher. Bonita Park reminds all guests to drink a lot of water while they are at this elevation. We would like to help that process by purchasing a full kitchen Reverse Osmosis system.

Estimated Cost: \$23,500

Skilled Labor

Licensed electricians, plumbers, large equipment operators, and those skilled in miscellaneous appliance repair are among the camp's greatest needs. Power Ascender



Bonita Park is in the market for a power ascender device. This device could assist campers who may have only dreamed of climbing the zipline tower! It could also be very useful in the maintenance department.

Still So Many Water Heaters!

Bonita Park goes through **SO MANY** water heaters, both residential and industrial. This remains a continuous need for staff housing and guest lodging. **There are currently 18 water heaters on campus that are beyond the end of their warranty.** This is a gift that keeps on giving as everyone loves hot water! 😊

Cost per Appliance: \$800 - \$2,000
Suggested Donation: \$100 - \$500



Continuing Need for Mini Splits

If you've ever stayed in Ingram Village in the summer, we don't need to tell you how hot it can get. To make our guests more comfortable, we realize that air conditioning is a necessity in the camp's dorm-style lodging. In addition, Freeman Village A & B heaters are aging out quickly and in desperate need of replacement to ensure our guests have a pleasant, warm stay in the winter. **Bonita Park is actively seeking bids for the electrical upgrade portion of this project!**

Total Cost: \$75,000 - \$100,000

Received to Date: \$71,397

Golf Cart Batteries

Bonita Park utilizes golf carts as we are able. Besides being very helpful on housekeeping days and to run quick errands for guests, they are just super fun to drive to the mailbox! While the actual carts that we own remain in very good condition, alas, the batteries do not.

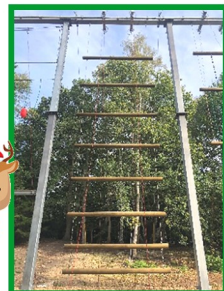

Water Tanks

Bonita Park has engaged an engineering firm to begin this process!! While the Camp Board has approved the purchase of tanks that will move the camp forward into the next century, there are several steps required before purchasing the actual tanks. This new storage system is required to ensure that the camp remains in compliance with state regulations as well as to sustain the community and camp infrastructure. The estimated cost below includes, but is not limited to, mandated engineered plans, site testing, storage tanks, updated infrastructure and removal of old tanks. Donors have currently given **\$70,000** to this vitally important project! **THANK YOU!!**
