Sunday, February 17, 4–5 p.m. • Fellowship Hall

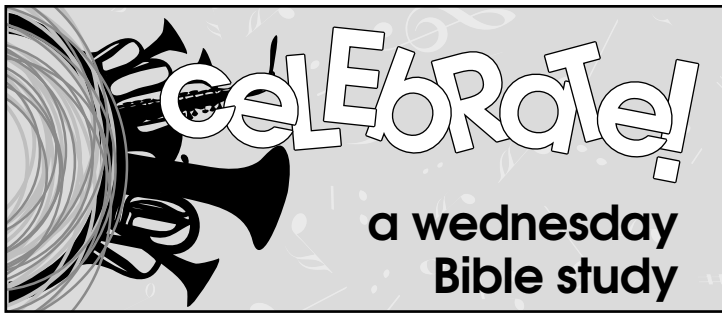
