Holy Week



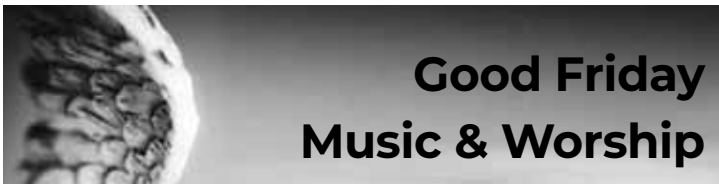
Prayer & Communion

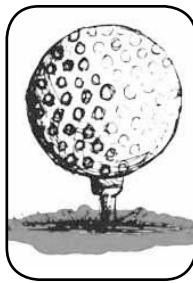
