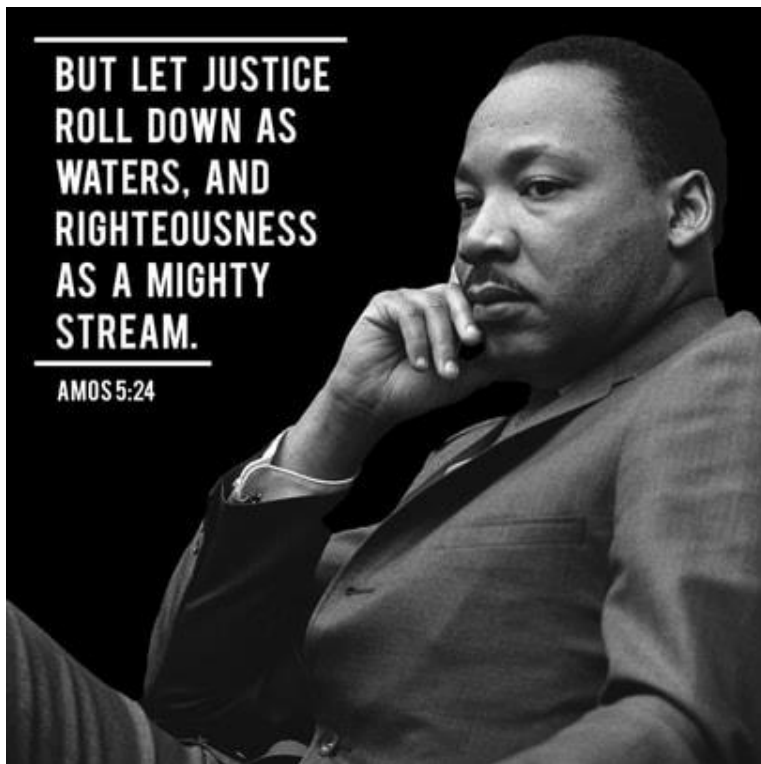

## SCRIPTURE

- 💧 "I am the vine, you are the branches. Those who abide in me and I in them bear much fruit." — John 15:5
- 💧 "But let justice roll down like waters, and righteousness like an ever-flowing stream." — Amos 5:24

## Reflection

- 💧 Jesus reminds us that life flows from staying connected to him. We do not generate fruit on our own—we receive it through abiding. Amos reminds us what that fruit looks like in the world: justice that moves, righteousness that does not dry up, love that reshapes how people are treated.

## Reflection Questions

- 💧 Where do I feel most connected to God right now?
- 💧 What fruit is visible in my life?
- 💧 Where might God be inviting justice or compassion to flow through me?
- 💧 What comforts or habits might I need to change so that new growth can emerge?
