



Growth Groups: Week 8 (11/5-9)

Confession: What do you need to confess? (Here are some questions to help you examine ways you might not be believing the Gospel).

- What consumes your thoughts when you have alone time?

Learning: What are you learning?

- What are you reading in the Bible? What did you learn about God? What did you learn about the Gospel?
- How is consistency?

Accountability: How can your Growth Group hold you accountable this week?

- This ties in with the confession questions. This is a practical way to walk together to identify sin and pursue sanctification together.
- How can your Growth Group help point each other to the Gospel daily? Come up with practical ways to follow through.

Prayer & Praise: How can we pray for you? What are you praising God for?

Scripture Memory: **John 14:6** – “Jesus said to him, “I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.”

John 14 - The Way, the Truth and the Life

When they were ready to enter the Promised Land, Moses told Israel that there were two ways set before them: the way of life and the way of death. He exhorted them to follow God and to trust Him at His word. This was the way of life ([Deut. 30:15-20](#)). When they arrived in the Promised Land, they followed foreign idols and many different ways of living. These things led to death and not God.

In Jesus' day, there were still many competing ways to live life. From

Greek philosophy to polytheism to Pharisaic legalism, people were being led astray. But Jesus tells His disciples that He is the true revelation from the Father and grants true life. Jesus is the only way to the Father, and no one comes to the Father but through Him.

Read John 14:1-14 together & summarize it

Discuss on the text:

- The disciples are upset that Jesus will be leaving them. What does Jesus say will happen when he goes to be with the Father?
- What do you think are the greater things the disciples will do (14:12)?
- What does it mean to say that Jesus is:
 - The way?
 - The truth?
 - The life?

Application:

- Are you participating in doing the greater things that Jesus mentioned in 14:12? What are some examples of greater things? Do you believe you should be doing these?
- How does knowing that Jesus is the truth and the life affect your actions and attitudes?
