Wee Care's director, Tracey Brown, along with the advisory board, has worked hard to create and incorporate a new organization and find a location that will serve Wee Care families well for years to come.

The things that make Wee Care the place we love will not change. Wee Care will operate in a new place, but its focus, approach, and purpose will remain the same.

What does this mean for you? Currently, the new location at 286 Maple Avenue is under renovation and the new Wee Care is set to launch on or before June 29, 2019. While Wee Care will no longer operate in the church building after next June, Tracey will continue to keep Wee Care families up-to-date regarding the progress of the move and what we all can anticipate in the new year.
