4. So far we have studied 119:1-16. Identify the different terms that describe God's Word in those verses.
5. How can we make God's commands central in our lives while avoiding cold, sterile legalism?
6. Looking back, what situation or relationship do you now wish you had handled with greater wisdom? What lesson did God teach you?
7. What is the relationship between Jesus Christ and wisdom?
