**TEXT:** Psalm 9:10 and Psalm 119:130

**CONSIDER THIS:** One of the most exciting ways to do a survey of the Bible is to study the Old Testament names of God and then connect them to Jesus Christ in the New Testament. Everything in the universe and all the events of history, from the greatest to the smallest, connect to Jesus Christ. Christian, since Christ lives in you, all the moments and circumstances of your life personally connect you to the One Who is above all things. Discovering what this means will reveal **THE STORY OF YOUR LIFE**. Today we will see how the names of God testify of God's great love for you and the priceless promises that are yours through Jesus Christ. You are more blessed than you can possibly imagine.

**KEY:** Christian, in a real sense the Bible is an autobiography of God as told through His names. The autobiography of God is the foundation for your biography, and it is glorious!

We are clothed in Christ.  
(Isaiah 61:10A; Galatians 3:26-27)

**Jehovah M'Kaddesh**

(The LORD Who Sanctifies)  
Leviticus 20:7-8

through Christ (Hebrews 10:10-14;  
I Thessalonians 5:23-24). Our "position"  
in Christ is eternally secure while our  
"practice" is a process with mixed results.

**Jehovah Shalom**

(The LORD our Peace)  
Judges 6:23-24

Why Gideon was afraid  
(Exodus 20:18-19; 33:19-23)

Jesus Christ died so that we could have Shalom from God.

**Jehovah Rapha**

(The LORD who heals)  
Exodus 15:23-26

This includes, but is not limited to, physical healing.



Jesus Christ heals us from the true disease – **SIN**. (I Peter 2:25).

He is the Living Water (John 4:7-14).

**Jehovah Rohi**

(The LORD my Shepherd)

Psalm 23:1



Jesus, the Good Shepherd  
Who died for me.

(I Peter 2:25; John 10:11-15)

**Jehovah Sabaoth**

(The LORD Almighty/  
The LORD of Heaven’s Armies)

I Samuel 17:45



Jesus Christ has overcome on our behalf and He brings His victory to us.  
(Romans 8:31, 36-39;  
Revelation 19:11-16)

**Jehovah(Shammah)**

(The LORD is there) Ezekiel 48:35.  
The loss of Paradise (Genesis 3:23)  
and the loss of God’s presence in the Temple (Ezekiel 10:18-19)  
will be restored.



To live forever in the presence of Jesus Christ (John 14:3; Revelation 21:1-3, 22).  
What truly makes Heaven wonderful is that we are with Him.

Christian, every “Jehovah” (LORD) name is a promise to you from the God Who makes and keeps promises. He **provides** (Jehovah Jireh) His **righteousness** (Jehovah Tsidkenu), **holiness** (Jehovah M’Kaddesh) **peace** (Jehovah Shalom) and **healing** (Jehovah Rapha). He is our **Shepherd** (Jehovah Rohi) and our **Protector**, and we will **live with Him forever** (Jehovah Shammah). All of these promises are fulfilled by Jesus Christ through His death on the cross for us. Paradise was lost in Genesis 3; Paradise will be restored in Revelation 21, and everything in between points to **CHRIST**. You are loved more than you can understand or know.
