

ALL: May these elements of light help us to welcome the world's true Light, which darkness cannot overcome.


CALL TO CONFESSION



THE LORD'S PRAYER

BREAKING OF THE BREAD AND POURING OF THE WINE

God is present in this sacrament in ways that remain a mystery to us. In this sacrament God connects us to one another beyond our understanding, location and time.

Communion of the People: **For in-person worshippers**: The outer ring is wine (red). All the inner rings are white grape juice (gluten free). Inside the pouch marked "Gluten Free" are gluten free crackers.

For remote worshippers: Use your own cup and bread.

Take and eat the bread as it is passed, symbolizing your personal need for God's mercy. Hold the cup until all have received it, and then drink together, symbolizing our unity in the body of Christ.


