

ALL: May we all hear, sing, pray, and live the word of God.


### CALL TO CONFESSION


One: Lift up your hearts.


### THE LORD'S PRAYER

Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come, thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors; and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, forever. Amen.

### BREAKING OF THE BREAD AND POURING OF THE WINE

God is present in this sacrament in ways that remain a mystery to us. In this sacrament God connects us to one another beyond our understanding, location and time.

Communion of the People: For in-person worshippers: The outer ring is wine (red). All the inner rings are white grape juice (gluten free). Inside the pouch marked "Gluten Free" are gluten free crackers. For remote worshippers: Use your own cup and bread. Take and eat the bread as it is passed, symbolizing your personal need for God's mercy. Hold the cup until all have received it, and then drink together, symbolizing our unity in the body of Christ.



### PRAYER OF CHRISTIAN UNITY

We have celebrated together in the wondrous and mysterious meal around this table. We ask that you continue to nourish us with the presence of your Holy Spirit, that we may be inspired to feed your people in need from the abundance of our own tables, that we may be transformed in this sacrament to be more like our Savior, Jesus Christ. Amen.
