


**CALL TO CONFESSION**

## **Prayer Vigil - Friday March 6 - Sunrise to Sunset**

### **Following Jesus in a Fractured World**

At First Presbyterian of Grapevine, we have the common belief of following Jesus. What did Jesus do to minister to people in the troubled world of his time?

First, he prayed. So, let's follow his model, seeking discernment for how we might actively serve in our community. To join in the World Day of Prayer, a prayer vigil is scheduled for Friday, March 6. A sign up sheet for time slots is available in the Narthex and will also be available online.

1. **Who?** Anyone and everyone.
2. **What?** Dedicated time of prayer.
3. **Where?** In the church sanctuary, in your home or at another place of your choice.
4. **When?** World Day of Prayer, Friday March 6, sign up to cover a 15 minute time slot by using this QR code or paper schedule sheet on the table in Narthex.
5. **Why?** Follow the model of Jesus who would withdraw to a quiet place to pray as he ministered to the multitudes. May we seek discernment for ways to minister to our community.
6. **How?** Use the prayer model from website <http://worlddayofprayer.net/program.html>, use The Lord's Prayer, use our church's prayer list, use your own words and concerns.

\* Special note about time schedule for use of Sanctuary. On Fridays our building is usually open from 9am-noon. However, on that day someone will also be in the building from noon until 6:15 pm.
