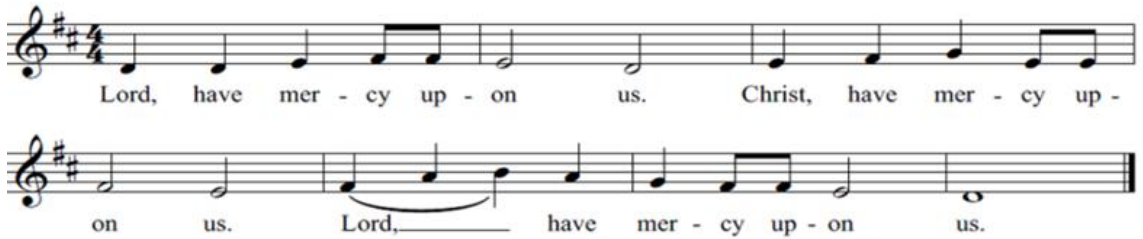
CALL TO CONFESSION
