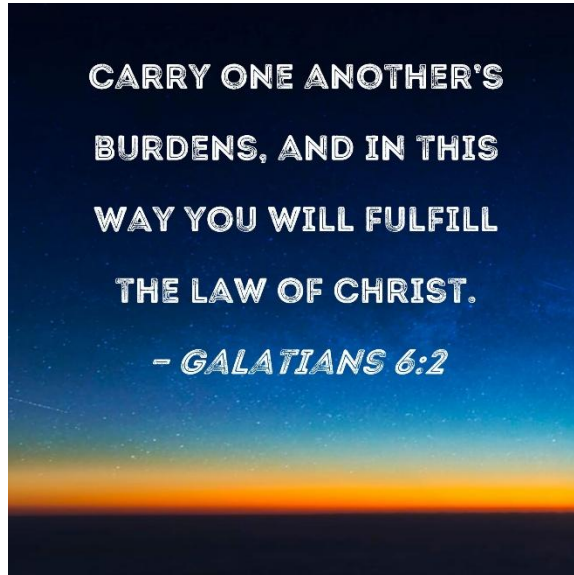

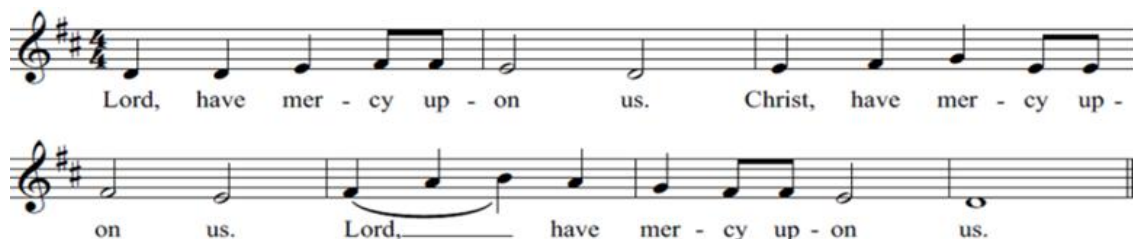
CALL TO CONFESSION
