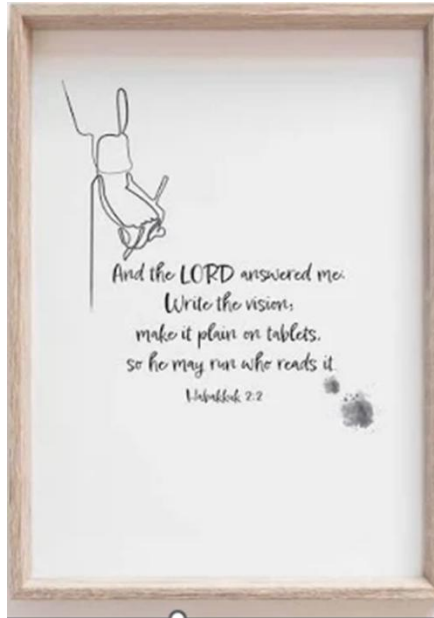

One: Let us prepare our hearts to worship God.

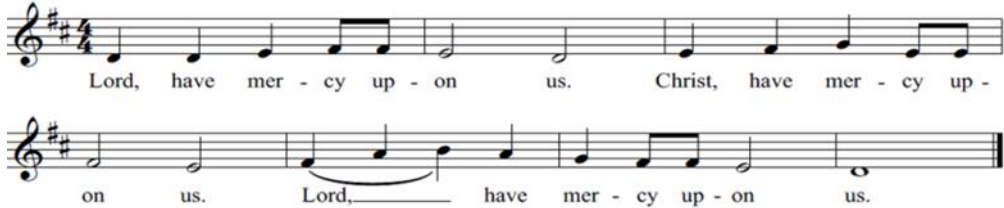
CALL TO CONFESSION
