Psalm 127:1 - House a dwelling place - a person's heart
- life choices
- Matthew 7:24-27
- church as a household - Galatians 6:10

The Foundation

Matthew 16:16-18 - God is the supreme architect, Jesus is the master builder. The Holy Spirit is the agent who gathers the material needed for the project. We are the materials
- Church built on those who make Peter's confession their own.

Previous Construction Projects

Psalm 102:5 Original creation included humankind who chose sin. Humans expelled from Eden (Gen:3) to the Land of Nod (curse)
Revelation 13:8 = God's plan B

The Church's Foundation

Isaiah 28:16 , Romans 9:33 - cornerstone marks identity – sure foundation is end to anxiety and fear. 1 Cor. 3:11, Psalm 118:22 (Matt. 21:42, Mark 12:10, Luke 20:17, Acts 4:11, 1Peter 2:4)

The Walls

1 Peter 2: 4-5 inanimate stones with life - a picture of hearts hardened by sin coming to life. Ephesians 2: 19-22 - strength through connection, inter-dependence. Isaiah 28:17 - keeping the church true through the Word of God.

The Furniture

The grace of God - The gifts of the Spirit

The Roof

The covering and protection of God Himself

The Door

Isaiah 60:18, John 10:7-9
