Today in the life of our church

Welcome to CFC! It's Pentecost Sunday! Christians around the world will be celebrating this day with great joy. Some Christian traditions refer to Pentecost Sunday as 'Whitsunday or White Sunday' - as the liturgical colour for major feast days (Easter, Christmas etc) is white! However, in more recent years on Whitsunday the white has given way to red! Pentecost is known as the "Birthday of the Church".

Some church traditions publish prayers as a part of liturgical worship. The following prayer for Pentecost is taken from the 'Canadian Anglican Book of Common Prayer', published in 1962.

Through Jesus Christ our Lord; according whose most true promise, the Holy Spirit came down as at this time from heaven, lighting upon the disciples to teach them, and to lead them into all truth; giving them both the gift of tongues, and also boldness with fervent zeal constantly to preach the Gospel unto all nations; whereby we have been brought out of darkness and error into the clear light and true knowledge of thy Son Jesus Christ.....

Missions Giving January to May, 2019

Missions giving refer to offerings we receive and pass on to others to help in their ministries both here at home and abroad. In the first five months of this year you gave a total of \$21,720 for missions. In addition, the elders of the church added \$5000 from our general operating account for a total of \$26,720.

So far this year we have disbursed the following to missions:

• Archway Counselling, New Glasgow	- \$ 1,000
• Ethnos Canada - undesignated	1,000
• Ethnos - missionary support	19,000
• Watoto village, Kampala, Uganda	3,600
• JAM (Joint Aid Management)	<u>2,000</u>
	Total - \$ 26,600

Notes:

- Archway Counselling is a professional Christian counselling service. For those who cannot afford the fees, subsidized help is provided, thus the reason for our support.
- Ethnos, which means 'ethnic group' is committed to sharing the gospel of Jesus to remote areas of the globe.
- Watoto, which means "village", rescues abandoned and orphaned children in Kmpolo, Uganda. They also provide homes, job training for abused and impoverished adults, many who are women.
- JAM is a Christian food aid ministry that partners with other organizations in feeding over one million people daily in Africa.
