What To Pack

- Bible (**PRINT COPY**) notepad, and pens/pencils
- Towels, wash cloths, toiletries, and shower shoes
- Bedroll/sleeping bag / pillow (for twin-sized bunk beds).
- Work clothes and work gloves
- Casual wear for at night and appropriate sleeping attire.
- Closed-toed shoes for ministry sites
- Personal water bottles for use while on the mission sites
- Sunscreen & Bug Spray
- **Spending money**
 - Money for Wednesday night meal (\$15-20) & Putt-Putt wristbands (\$20)
 - Money for ice cream on a couple of afternoons (Jerry's, Baskin Robbins)
 - Plenty of \$1 bills or quarters for the vending machines.
 - Sales table money.

Optional Stuff

- Snacks
- Sunglasses / Hat
- Cell Phones (see section on Cell Phone rules on the "All Summer Trips" handout)
- Water spray bottles
- Paper towels / Baby wipes / Hand sanitizer
- Picture Bible, extra Gospel tracts

Dress code for Street Reach

- **At all times...**
 - Casual wear is appropriate for the whole week. However, modesty is essential.
 - No short shorts. **Mid-length to knee or longer** is suitable.
 - Students must be fully dressed any time you are out of the room.
 - No tank tops, spaghetti strap shirts, etc. **Shirts must have sleeves**. If the sleeves have been cut/torn off or rolled up, then it no longer has sleeves and doesn't meet dress code.
 - Yoga pants, tights, and leggings are not acceptable pants. These may not be worn outside your assigned sleeping room unless layered underneath shorts or pants.
 - Do not pack t-shirts or other apparel with any questionable logos
- **On the Ministry Sites during the day...**
 - T-shirts & shorts are appropriate. However, you should wear clothes you can get dirty. Light-colored t-shirts are highly recommended due to the sun and heat.
 - Closed-toe shoes are required. No sandals. Also, be sure your shoes are comfortable for walking long distances.
- **At Night...**
 - Casual wear is appropriate (t-shirt and shorts).
 - Sandals are allowed.
- Violations of the dress code will result in the offender being asked to change and/or losing free time or the right to participate in activities.
