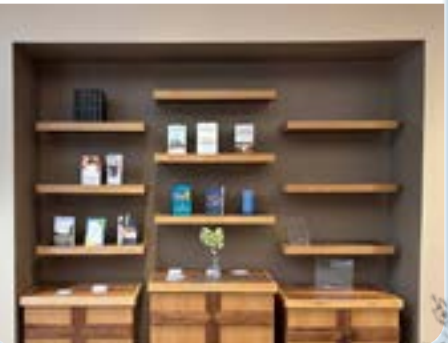
THE 55+ FALL RETREAT is just around the corner.
