A Word On Safety

Spokane Christian Center and Spokane Christian Schools are committed to the safety and well-being of our children. To do so we need your help. **Anytime** you enter the building (aside from drop off and pick up), please stop to sign in and receive a "Visitor" tag.

- O If you are coming to SCA, **stop** in the school office.
- O If you are here on church business or any other purpose, **stop** at the front desk.

This helps all of our staff know that you are approved to be in the building. Your cheerful and ready observance of this policy is most helpful. It only takes a moment to safe guard your children, just as it only takes a moment to jeopardize that safety.

Please schedule your visit ahead of time and postpone your visit if you are sick.

End of day departure is staggered to minimize crowding and traffic. Only enter the loading zone at the time your student is dismissed (not before):

•3:05: 4th-5th grade

•3:10: 6th–10th grade

If you are picking up multiple students (or if you arrive before your students' dismissal time), please pull out of the loading zone into a parking spot to wait.


Food Punch Cards on sale NOW!
