2024 Scouting Recap Colonial Heights Presbyterian Church

Throughout 2024, a total of 81 unique scouts (boys and girls) participated in Troop 48 activities and attended meetings at CHPC. The troop also had 71 registered adult leaders.

Activities:

Throughout the year 2024, 81 different Troop 48 Scouts, participated in 138 scouting activities including Klondike Derby Practice, Klondike Derby, Conservation Projects, Dick Tracy Rock, OA Events, Patrol Outings, Various Hikes, Orienteering, Channels Hike, Merit Badge Universities, JLT, Color guards, Navitat Canopy, Snow Tubing, Fun Fest Parade, Crazy 8 Service, Cherokee Trip, New York City Trip, CHPC Pool Party, CHPC Pumpkin Patch, Continuous Campfire – Food Drive, and Scout Sunday Service. Attendance: Troop 48 Scouts, on 2,120 individual occurrences, attended Scout Meetings.

A total of 85 Troop 48 scouts spent a total of 1,095 nights camping, at Camp Davy Crockett, Colonial Heights Presbyterian Church, Obed Recreational Area, Bays Mountain Park, Dick Tracy Rock, OA Outings, Cherokee, Virgin Falls, Warriors Path State Park, Grayson Highlands, Hungry Mother State Park, Cumberland Gap, Sea Base, Bechtel Summit, and various Patrol Campouts in the area.
