PNC Update

Your PNC met this past Monday (11/16) to consider a third group of referred pastor candidates. The committee has now reviewed 75 Pastor Information Forms and listened to and watched many hours of online sermons as we considered the candidates presented. We are in contact with a half dozen candidates from this third group and hoping to schedule a zoom meeting interview with them in the next few weeks. One of the candidates has already responded and we will be talking to that candidate next Monday evening. To date, we have conducted two zoom interviews with candidates from previous referred groups, and are in communication with a couple of other candidates relative to scheduling an interview.

We hope to complete all of these first round interviews early in December and then move on to a second round of interviews with each candidate who the committee felt positively about before Christmas. Committee members are becoming quite proficient at finding recent sermons from each of the candidates and have listened to at least five different sermons on the parable of the talents just in the last week. We will provide more updates as the process moves forward.

Thanksgiving Food Boxes

This year due to Covid-19, the church will not be making individual food boxes. Instead, if you would like to participate, you can make a donation of \$25 to be put towards a food box. Make the check payable to Colonial Heights Presbyterian Church, and in the memo line put Thanksgiving food box. Colonial Heights Christian Church will purchase the food to put in the boxes. *Checks must be turned into the office no later than Monday, November 23. Thank you!*

Blessing Box

We will be installing in a "Blessing Box" on the premises. Blessing boxes are stocked with nonperishable food items, basic toiletries, baby supplies, and anything else that might be considered a blessing to someone who finds themselves in need. Items are anonymously donated and anonymously received. A simple rule applies - Leave what you can, take what you need. We will let you know when our blessing box is ready to stock! Help us bridge the gap to reduce food insecurity in families around us!

Volunteers Needed

Second Harvest Food Bank does a monthly food distribution for local families in need. In October, 1,035 families in our region waited in line one Saturday morning to receive food assistance from Second Harvest and that number is expected to increase in November and December. The need in our area is great right now due to COVID. CHPC has reserved a spot for 15-20 volunteers to help with one of the distribution sites at their facility at 1020 Jericho Drive, Kingsport at the December 12, 2020 distribution from 10am-1pm. Volunteers are needed to help register families (from their vehicles), provide traffic control, load trunks with food, and guide vehicles out of the distribution site. Traffic is heavy during distribution time, so it is recommended that you plan to arrive on site by 9:45am. The minimum age to volunteer is 10 years old, you must wear a mask (no exceptions) and close toed shoes, and no phones or earbuds may be in use while volunteering.
