Dear Church Family,

Being a people on the move entails a lot of preparation. The month of May flew by while packing boxes, holding garage sales and saying our goodbyes to 1300 Melrose. In June, we were busy stacking and restacking hymnals, learning a new technology system, coordinating Vacation Bible School and participating in local service projects like Feed My Starving Children MobilePack and Friends Acting in the Holy Spirit (F.A.I.T.H.S.).

Moving from one church location to the next, we are also transitioning from one capital campaign to another. Bruce Hudson and Becky Benson conclude, "It has been a privilege to be the campaign directors for Our Journey with Christ from 2013-2016. God continues to show his faithfulness to us through the generosity of his people. At our conclusion of the Our Journey with Christ campaign, we have a 90% completion on pledges with \$1,972,092 raised."

Sustaining the funding of our current building project continues with the With Our Eyes on Christ capital campaign from 2016-2019. To date the campaign includes 139 families or individuals pledging a total of \$1,326,158. In June, we received the final payment from Jeff Maxwell for the sale of our Melrose property. The finance team is working with Two Rivers Bank regarding loan options for the remaining cost of the building construction.

In Luke 10, when Martha says "Lord, don't you care that my sister has left me to do all the work by myself!?" Jesus reminds her, "You are worried and upset about many things, but few things are needed. . . indeed only one." In our move from 1300 Melrose to our transition locations in Coralville, what a peace to remember that only one thing matters, and we find that peace in Jesus Christ.

Thank you for all your feedback during the campaign pledging process. Each one of you contributes unique gifts to our church. We pray that, daily, you and your family find yourselves sitting at the feet of Jesus.
