Veda Gill in the Pulpit June 25



Ms. Veda Gill, Executive Director of the Presbyterian Education Board (PEB) in Pakistan, will preach at both services on Sunday, June 25. Veda will share with us how Presbyterian Christian witness in Pakistan since 1854 has brought both hope through the Gospel, and opportunity through education, particularly at the Pasrur Christian School, near Lahore, Pakistan. At Pasrur, boys and girls from both Christian and Muslim families are educated through 5th grade, and girls through high school. However, co-

education beyond 5th grade is not permitted, owing to social custom. Boys at Pasrur, therefore, miss out on both advanced education, and job opportunities. Many are forced to seek work at a nearby brick kiln under hard conditions, and with low pay (a mere \$2.00/1000 bricks made!).

There will be an opportunity to meet Veda and ask questions between services. In addition, Amy and Dave Nicholson will be hosting a potluck in their home following the second service. The Nicholsons will provide the main dish, so please bring sides, desserts, or salads. Their address is 1334 Santa Fe Drive, Iowa City. Look forward to seeing you there!

Happy Tummies Supplies Needed & Packing Party

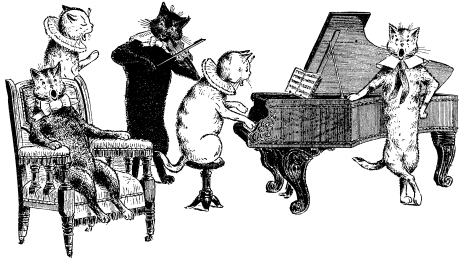
