It would require some boundary-setting by the couple and the church if it came to fruition during the search process. The (MDP) Ministry Discernment Profile states the mission and vision of the church and PNC hopes to tweak the form they had developed last summer for a co-pastor. A job description is needed for the head of staff for PNC to work with. Ted was thanked for his time updating Session on the PNC's work to date.

New Business

- PNC- session could develop a job description for the lead pastor position and designate a salary range, along with providing the PNC with the church mission statement or this can be done in conjunction with the PNC. . It was determined the PNC should proceed with this job description development and research on salary ranges and present a draft to the session for review.

- Consider designating a liaison from PNC to report at each session meeting on progress.
 - Discussion: PNC would need to ask candidates if they would perform same-sex marriage ceremonies, but this need not be in the job description itself. Session was looking at how the inclusion policy is written and may want to review this. The PNC can collaborate with Session in melding the lead and associate pastor job descriptions into a new job description. The qualification regarding ordination in the Presbyterian Church might need to be altered as we are in communion with other denominations and pastors in good standing with their respective ecclesial body would be eligible to apply for the lead pastor position. Use the phrase, "parish experience or equivalent" in the list of qualifications.
 - Salary research is being done by a member of the PNC & can be reviewed with the finance team and session.
 - Session determined they would session like a liaison from PNC reporting monthly to session, with a written report also submitted to session listing milestones they have achieved. Down the line, knowing what questions potential candidates are asking and what they have to say about St Andrew would be beneficial for session to know.
