## **What is Camp Stronghold?**

Camp Stronghold is a Presbyterian camp located in Oregon, IL, which is along the Rock River, and just south of Rockford, IL. The camp was originally owned by Walter and Josephine Strong. Mr. Strong was the owner of the Daily Chicago News! Many of Mr. Strong's newspaper peers built lavish homes, including the "Hearst" castle in California. Not to be outdone, Mr. Strong purchased over 360 acres and built himself a castle. His 1930s castle included 16 bedrooms, 9 bathrooms, and a swimming pool. The Strong's sold the property to the Presbyterian Church in 1962 and summer camps have been happening there ever since!
