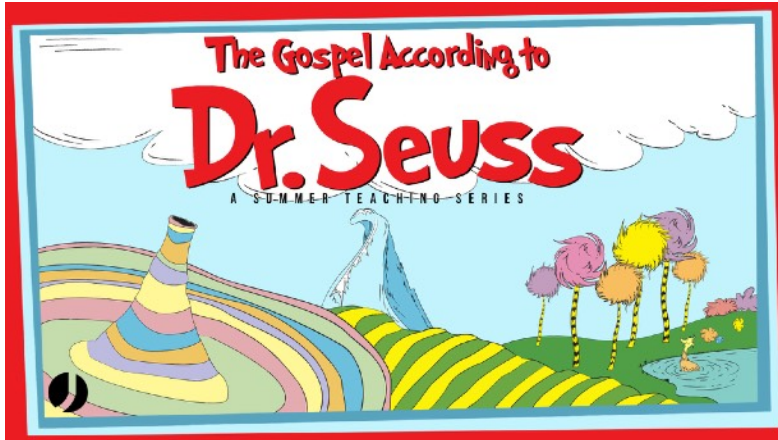


Summer Christian Education Options at St. Andrew

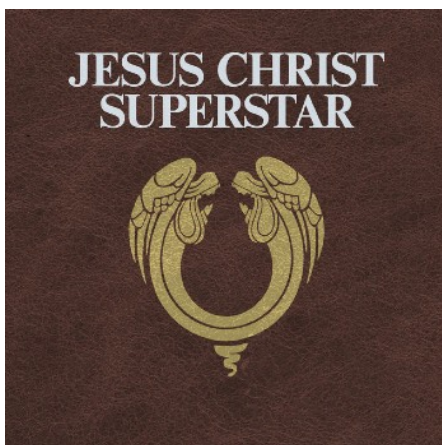
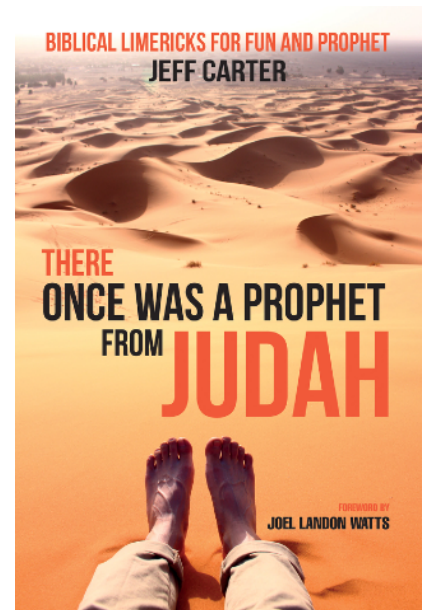
St. Andrew will offer the following Christian Education options during the hour between Sunday worship services in June and July:



“The Gospel According to Dr. Seuss”: Heather Woodin, director of family and children’s ministries, will lead a fun-filled, four-week, family-friendly exploration of the biblical echoes in the stories and drawings of Theodor Seuss Geisel — better known as Dr. Seuss. *(June 17, June 24, July 8 and July 15, Children’s Room)*

“The Friendship Foundation for a Thriving Marriage”: Just in time for Father’s Day, Pastor Kyle Otterbein will share some of the key insights on marriage that he has gained through his training as a 7 Principles Program Educator for the Gottman Institute. *(June 17, Youth Room)*

“Digging into the Scriptures Five Rhymes at a Time”: Join writer/poet Jeff Carter to discuss his latest book, “There Once Was a Prophet From Judah: Biblical Limericks for Fun and Prophet.” The author of “Muted Hosannas,” Jeff spent 18 years as a minister of the gospel serving as an officer in The Salvation Army.
