



Summer Lunches for Pheasant Ridge Kids

St. Andrew is partnering with the Pheasant Ridge Neighborhood Center to serve lunches to children this summer. We need many volunteers from St. Andrew to make this happen!

The Iowa City Community School District will deliver sack lunches to the neighborhood center from June 10 to August 2. The free lunch is for anyone under 18, regardless of family income or address. The center has the space for this program but not the volunteers.

St. Andrew has committed to providing volunteers to go to the center from noon to 2:00 pm Monday-Friday throughout the summer. That time includes serving lunch and helping to supervise an easy activity or game for children.

Volunteers can sign up to serve just one time during the summer, for an entire week, or multiple times. We expect about 20 children to attend for lunch and the activities.

Please consider inviting your family, small group, or friends to sign up to volunteer. Children under 18 can eat for free. Students in junior high and high school can serve as helpers alongside two adult volunteers.

The Summer Lunch program is an outgrowth of the School's Out Day Camp held at St. Andrew. The day camp is for children with limited resources who attend Weber, Borlaug, and Horn elementary schools. Many of the children who attended during the school year live in the Pheasant Ridge neighborhood.
