

Brothers and sisters in Christ, Happy New Year!

Here we are upon the Third Sunday in Ordinary Time and the season of Lent this year will be upon us in less than a month! Are we prepared? In the Gospel this weekend, Jesus picks up where St. John the Baptist left off. "Repent" in the Greek means a change of mind. Is there any area of our life where we need to change our minds? Is there any area of our life that needs a new year's resolution? It won't happen without some change of mind. We are held back by false notions of God in the life that He has given us, and the mind is the battle-field. Truth is necessary to grow in love, to grow in God. God is truth. Jesus said that He is "the Way, the Truth, and the Life." All things are resolved in Him. We may try to solve our concerns and desires elsewhere, but if we're honest, doesn't it always come back to Jesus? Are we satisfied with something else? In fact, things in and of themselves don't satisfy. We were made for love and our deepest desire is to be loved. "Our hearts are restless until they rest in thee..." - St. Augustine
