Deacon's Corner

Dear Friends,

On this Palm Sunday, the Church begins the passage between the Lent and Easter seasons—Holy week and the Sacred Triduum. This is the most sacred time of the liturgical year as Jesus enters the Holy City and we contemplate His Passion, Death, and Resurrection and we recite the Passions texts in Mark's Gospel today, and in the Gospel of John on Good Friday. The hour that Jesus and His disciples have been anticipating has come—Jesus' death on the cross, where blood and water gushed forth as a fountain of mercy for us. This is where our salvation comes from—for the sake of His sorrowful passion. I have often pondered that although the evilest thing that ever occurred in history happened on Good Friday, the reason it is called "Good" Friday is because of Divine Mercy.

Every once in a while I like to recommend a good book for spiritual reading. So, this time I offer the book *Understanding Divine Mercy* by Fr. Chris Alar, MIC. I have always held the prayers and devotion to the Divine Mercy, as inspired by the great Saint Faustina in her Diary, in the highest regard in my prayer life. This book explains why it is so critical for our times and summarizes it in an easy-to-understand way. Pope St. John Paul II said, "There is nothing that man needs more than Divine Mercy." Jesus Himself told Saint Faustina, "Divine Mercy is mankind's last hope of salvation." If you don't pass through the doors of His mercy, you must pass through the doors of His justice, and we certainly don't want the latter! I would like to invite us all not only to pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet during Holy Week (or anytime of the year), but to join in praying the Novena for Divine Mercy in the Church. The Novena begins on Good Friday and ends on Divine Mercy Sunday (April 7). I will be giving a short talk on Divine Mercy Sunday during the Holy Hour with Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, Chaplet of Divine Mercy, and Benediction (see the front of this bulletin for the schedule).
