Roberta Pippitt, founder of Heather Chimhoga Orphan Care and the Zimbabwe Mission Partnership, who is now well into her 80s, admits her swing of the pick ax was "feeble." But the significance was earthshaking. Shown here being cheered on by Albert Mukondwa, CEO of HCOB, Roberta officially gets construction underway for the new clinic, where children will finally be cared for in clean, pleasant surroundings. The clinic is now fully approved by the government of Zimbabwe, and ongoing deliveries of life-saving AIDS drugs by UNICEF are assured once again. Construction of the clinic is being made possible, in part, by donations from members of EPC.
