**Spring 2 Action:** ALIVE! serves roughly 20,000 people each month in the City of Alexandria who need essential grocery items! ALIVE! is more than just Alexandria's food bank. We are proud to have helped Alexandrians in the following ways: Distributed more than 3 million pounds of food since the pandemic; provided shelter, virtual learning, and childcare to ALIVE! House shelter residents; supported 1,500 households with financial and rental assistance; launched the Alexandria Eviction Prevention Partnership to deliver over \$500,000 of direct rent relief to Alexandrian residents; provided housewares and furniture to Alexandrians coming from shelters and new refugee families. **ALIVE! Furniture Delivery:** Our list of families who want to donate furniture and those who need furniture continues to grow. We are now scheduling for dates in April, May, June, and July. Mike Souza (<a href="mailto:mmabuc85@gmail.com">mmabuc85@gmail.com</a>) has volunteered to lead FUMC's Furniture Delivery with ALIVE!. It does not need to be a daunting task to find volunteers; please reach out to Mike to get involved! So far in 2024, the Furniture Program has served 127 families – picking up 278 furniture items from 69 families and delivering them to 58 families.

Volunteers Needed in Del Ray and the West End Food Hubs: Help clients select grocery items in a mini-grocery-store like environment! Since these locations are open five days a week, they give clients greater flexibility for when they seek food assistance and the choice model for selecting items ensures clients are picking up the items they can use. This is a great activity if you are looking for weekday volunteer hours, speak languages other than English, want to help restock shelves, or are just are excited about helping people find food and other support resources. Space is limited at these locations, so be sure to reserve your volunteer shift in advance. 1hr to 2.5 hour shifts available and a longer shift on Saturdays.
