The Millennial Kingdom and Great White Throne Judgment

I. Why is there a Millennial Kingdom?

- 1. Humanity will see what God's plan for the world was before the Fall.
- 2. Christ will be King of this Earth!
- 3. The Jews will finally accept Jesus as Messiah.
- 4. The Creation will enjoy liberation from the curse.
- 5. Believers will learn to rule and reign as Christ's representatives.

6. All humanity will see the devil is not responsible for human rebellion against Christ.

7. Believers will enjoy their glorified bodies on this Earth.

II. What will our glorified bodies be like? (1 Corinthians 15.43-44)

- 1. Our bodies will be raised in glory.

1. The second death will take place for all the Unsaved of all time (Rev. 20.11-13).

2. Unbelievers will be judged according to their works (Rev. 20.12-13).

3. Unbelievers will be cast into the lake of fire for eternity (Rev. 20.14-15).
