We will once again decorate the sanctuary with Easter lilies on Easter Sunday. If you would like to purchase a lily, please sign up in the entryway. The cost is \$13. Checks can be made payable to First Lutheran Women Working for Christ.

SPECIAL VOTERS' MEETING

At the March 22 Special Voters' Meeting, the congregation approved moving forward with Phase II of the Every Step a Blessing campaign. This phase includes new flooring in the sanctuary, entryway, hallways, chapel, and offices, along with updates to office cabinetry and furnishings.

The approved plan features carpet in common areas and luxury vinyl tile in the sanctuary. The total project cost was approved not to exceed \$125,000.

Work is expected to begin this June, with worship temporarily moving to the gymnasium in June and returning to the sanctuary in late July.

We thank God for the continued generosity of our members, with nearly \$85,000 already received toward this project.
