Report on April 7 Administrative Council Meeting

- 1. Classical church visitors, Paul Nieman and Norman Jones, met with us for about an hour. It provided another opportunity for us to reflect on God's faithfulness to us as a congregation.
- 2. London Campus Ministry Committee has granted a three-month sabbatical to Chaplain Kelly Sibthorpe. We wish him much rest and renewal and God's blessing.
- 3. A small hiring committee has been mandated to interview candidates for the office administrator position and make a recommendation for hire to council.
- 4. We are still in the process of finalizing nominations for vacant council positions. Full council has asked Calvin Davies to extend his term for one year to provide more continuity for next year's council. He has agreed to do so and continue on as chair.
- 5. We have begun a discussion with Talbot St CRC to work together on our youth programs
- 6. Pete Van Geest presented a draft report of the recent work the visioning committee has done. Some revisions will be made before it is presented to full council.
