Genesis 1-4, 6



Genesis 1

1. What is the significance that only humans reflect the image of God?
2. How does Genesis 1:28-31 help you understand humanity's role in stewarding creation?

Genesis 2

1. Notice the depth of descriptiveness of the garden. What does this reveal about God's provision and love for humanity?
2. God's creation of Adam and Eve communicates that harmony with one another is an overflow of harmony with God. Why is it so vital that Christians practice biblical community together?

Genesis 3

1. How did the fall of Adam and Eve impact their relationship with God and with one another?
2. Surprisingly, chapter 3 is full of grace. What does God promise in verse 15 that gives hope to humanity? In verses 22-24, God removes them from the garden to prevent them from eating of the tree of life thus ensuring that they do not live in a perpetually sinful condition. How is this also an act of grace?

Genesis 4

1. What do Cain and Abel's offerings reveal about their hearts toward God?
2. Cain goes on to build a city where violence is common (epitomized by Lamech). Why did sin progress so quickly after the fall?

Genesis 6

1. What do verses 5-7 teach us about the status of humanity at that point?
2. How does Noah's obedience to God set him apart from others in his generation?
