Luke 2:10–11 (NLT) "Don't be afraid! I bring you good news that will bring great joy to all people. (11) The Savior—yes, the Messiah, the Lord—has been born today in Bethlehem, the city of David!"

Luke 2:20 (NLT) (20) The shepherds went back to their flocks, glorifying and praising God for all they had heard and seen. It was just as the angel had told them.

Luke 2:38 (NLT) (38) She came along just as Simeon was talking with Mary and Joseph, and she began praising God. She talked about the child to everyone who had been waiting expectantly for God to rescue Jerusalem.

Matthew 2:2 (NLT) (2) "Where is the newborn king of the Jews? We saw his star as it rose, and we have come to worship him."

Matthew 2:11 (NLT) (11) They entered the house and saw the child with his mother, Mary, and they bowed down and worshiped him. Then they opened their treasure chests and gave him gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh.

1 Peter 2:24 (NLT) (24) He personally carried our sins in his body on the cross so that we can be dead to sin and live for what is right. By his wounds you are healed.

1 Corinthians 10:31 (NLT) (31) So whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do it all for the glory of God.

Luke 9:23–24 (NLT) (23) Then he said to the crowd, "If any of you wants to be my follower, you must give up your own way, take up your cross daily, and follow me. (24) If you try to hang on to your life, you will lose it. But if you give up your life for my sake, you will save it.
