

OUR CORE VALUES:

1. SCRIPTURAL AUTHORITY

We believe the Bible is God's Word and we are committed to learning it and putting it into practice. It is completely reliable, without error — the sole authority of truth. God's Word gives us life and it is to be obeyed. (2 Timothy 3:16)

2. WORSHIP

We believe the church exists to worship God. We are called to honor and glorify God and this is not just simply a Sunday morning activity, but a lifestyle. We believe that corporate worship is fundamental for the well-being of the believer and the church as a whole. (Romans 12:1)

3. BIBLICAL TEACHING

We believe anointed teaching is the catalyst for change and growth in the life of both the individual and the church. This includes the concept of relevant teaching for life change. (Romans 12:7; 2 Timothy 3:16-17; James 1:23-25)

4. PRAYER

We believe prayer is the primary means through which we communicate with God, and it is necessary on a daily basis. (Luke 11:1-3)

5. EVANGELISM

We believe the church must reach unbelievers with the reality of Jesus Christ, and that this is the responsibility of every believer. (Matthew 28:18-19)

6. LIFE CHANGE

We believe that life transformation begins with a personal relationship with Jesus Christ and living a Christ-centered life should be the norm for every believer. (2 Corinthians 3)

7. AUTHENTIC COMMUNITY

We believe in authentic, loving relationships. Accountability, belonging, care and spiritual growth happen best with relationally-connected believers. (Luke 6:12-13; Acts 2:42-47)

8. MINISTRY

We believe that every person is gifted for some area of ministry, and that we are responsible to identify and use our spiritual gifts within the church body. (1 Corinthians 12:8-10)

9. EXCELLENCE

We believe in excellence in ministry, because it honors God and inspires people. We believe that an attitude of excellence and quality should permeate all that we do. (1 Corinthians 1:31)

10. MARRIAGE & FAMILY

We believe that God instituted monogamous marriage between male and female as the foundation of the family and the basic structure of human society. We believe that marriage is exclusively the union of one genetic male and one genetic female. (Genesis 2:24; Matthew 19:5-6; Mark 10:6-9; Romans 1:26-27; 1 Corinthians 6:9)
