Welcome to NewSong Church's Encounter Worship. We are so very thankful that you have chosen to join us today and we pray that God blesses each of you in a most personal, life-changing way as together we lift our praises to Him and receive a timely message anchored solidly in His unchanging Word and shared through the power of the Holy Spirit to each of our hearts today! ... G<sup>3</sup>! Today we will be hearing a timely message from the Lord which is built upon last week's message, "Going a Little Further (the Second Mile)" using the same Biblical context of Jesus and His disciples in the Garden of Gethsemane on the evening before His Crucifixion. So much spiritual warfare was occurring all around them as this prophetic night was unfolding - just mere hours before Jesus would be nailed to a cross to pay the penalty for our sins – death (2 Corinthians 5:21; Romans 6:23)! On several occasions Jesus had taught His disciples of the coming prophetic events of His arrest, crucifixion and resurrection, but sadly they all missed the vital point of understanding and remained spiritually asleep –unaware as to the prophetic events now taking place on that very evening. That's why Jesus had instructed them there in the Garden to "keep actively watching (stay awake CEV) and praving that you may not come into temptation; the spirit is willing, but the body is weak." (Matthew 26:41 Amplified) Although He knew they needed to remain spiritually alert and prepared for the horrific things that were to come later that night, He realized that because of their lack of understanding, they were not spiritually ready, thus, they would all fail Him that night as His followers by "running away / deserting - abandoning Him!" (Matthew 26:31) He had also invited their prayer support and encouragement as He "went a little further" to spend some intense prayer moments alone with His Father, surrendering all of His human nature to His Father's perfect will (Matthew 26:39). As He returned three separate times to the disciples. He found them sleeping each time. Thus, they were all left unprepared and unaware of His approaching betrayer (Judas) and Christ's subsequent arrest there in the Garden of Gethsemane (Matthew 26:47-50). Today may the eyes of our hearts be "wide awake and alert" as we listen to His call to be ever watchful and ready for His coming again (His return)! May today's message also challenge each of us to be alert / watchful at all times for the enemy's temptations in trying to thwart God's perfect will for our lives!
