

"... Will you ever follow Christ at a distance?" When Peter first faced that situation, he arrogantly proclaimed that he would never disown / deny Jesus, telling Jesus, "Lord, I am POWER OF PRA ready to go with You to prison and to death!" (Luke 22:34) Even though Jesus prophetically told Peter that he would deny Him



three times that very night, Peter would not listen to this truth—the reality of what surely was to take place on that same night. After Jesus' arrest that night, Peter, and all the disciples would desert Jesus and flee in fear for their lives. (Matthew 26:56) Peter did later return, following Jesus from amongst the crowd, "at a distance." (Luke 22:54) Sadly, a growing number of Christians today seem to be walking in the same shoes as Peter. They don't want to get too close to Jesus as others might think of them as a "religious zealot / fanatic." Some fear for their job security should they be "too Christian" amongst a culture that is rapidly, and unabashedly, denying any and all elements of Christianity. Others fear a strain or awkwardness in their relationships with family, friends, neighbors or the general public if they were to live out their faith boldly. One of the most disastrous lies dispersed by the devil is that we can live out our Christian faith as an "effective silent witness!" That's a spiritual impossibility! In today's message, we will look more closely at the heart shift in Peter's life that led him to deny Jesus three times as was prophesied. But alas, Peter's life story didn't end with these tragic denials ... there was a "rest of the story" to be lived out! \o/ ... G<sup>3</sup>! Pastor David
