





"... Allow Christ to RESTORE You today!" What an awesome journey through this past Holy Week-from our powerful Palm Sunday service to a truly anointed Maundy Thursday service to our arrival at Easter morning! God is so, so




good! This morning we turn our hearts to a new message from our Lord's heart on the divine work of *Restoration* in the lives of His children. Today we are continuing our focus from Palm Sunday on the imperfect life of Peter and the incredible message of hope that Jesus brought to him after His resurrection. As you recall, Peter, along with all of the fellow disciples, had all fled (ran away—abandoned; Matthew 26:56) Jesus upon His arrest in the Garden of Gethsemane. Peter, along with another disciple, had later returned that same evening, but chose to follow Jesus "at a distance." (Luke 22:54) Peter, just as Jesus had predicted earlier in the evening, would go on to deny Jesus publicly three times—leaving his confidence devastated and crushed for he truly loved Jesus, but his prophetic three denials had revealed a spiritual weakness in his faith life



that he had not recognized until that evening. Jesus knew Peter's heart and his urgent need for divine restoration of his faith trust and confidence...and that is exactly what Jesus undertook with Peter—and it would end up forever changing his life witness, giving it and his Kingdom mission both a supernatural infusion of boldness and divine strength that he would go on to carry with

him throughout his lifetime! How about YOU? Have you ever failed Jesus? Have you ever had an opportunity to proclaim Him publicly, yet chose for whatever reason to remain silent? We need to pay the cost—whatever that price might be (Luke 14:25-35)—so that we all might be a more bold, unapologetic witness for Christ Jesus! So let's examine Jesus' restoration of Peter in more detail this morning so that we too may take away a deeper understanding of His truth and lead us to become more faithful, surrendered follower of His ... Selah! \o/ ... G3! Pastor David
