2026 Mexico Mission Trip Information Sheet | June 4th-10th, 2026

Eligibility:

- Open to adults and students who will have completed grades 8-12 by June 2026, are presently attending our church or student ministry, and are actively serving in some capacity at church.
- The trip capacity is 20 individuals.
- Team leaders are Jonathan & Dana Witmer.

Missionaries we are serving with:

 Rod and Mayra have been ministering together in Mexico City since their marriage in Mexico in 1995 and returned to Mexico as a couple after a year in the U.S. in 1996. They have been ministering in the Mexico City metro area. While serving there they have helped to plant 3 churches (working on a 4th!), the most recent being the Palmas church, which was planted in November 2016.

Ministry Location and Focus:

- We will be serving again at the Fry's home ministry base in Ixtapaluca, on the eastern edge of Mexico City's metro area. While in Ixtapaluca, we will be staying in the homes of various church members of the Jesus Maria church.
- We will be partnering in ministry with members of the church in Jesus Maria as they reach out to their community in a variety of ways.... help run a young adult 2 day retreat for young adults, sports outreach, public school ministry, English classes, baking classes, glasses and hearing aid distribution, etc. Once we form our team, we will determine the area of ministry focus based on gifts and abilities. As is the case with most mission trips, being flexible and adaptable is going to be key as plans may change throughout the course of the trip based on the needs of the community/ministry.

- \$1,600 per person
