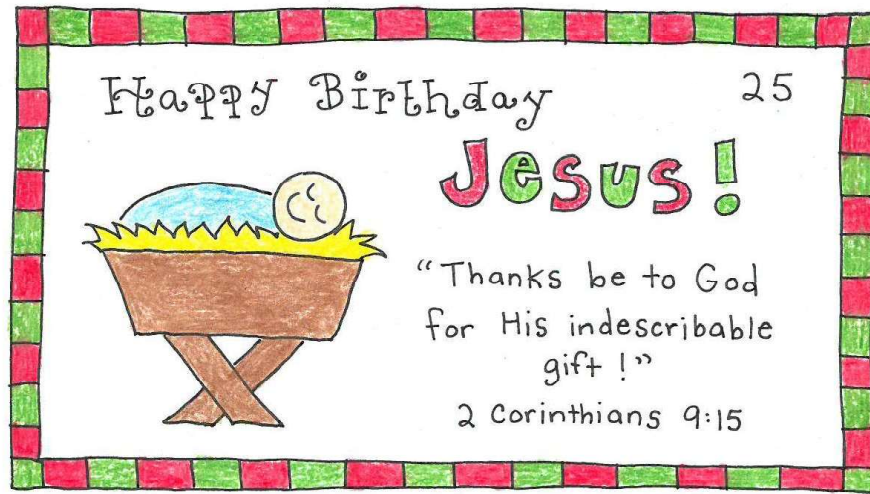


Christmas Scripture Countdown Cards

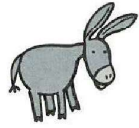
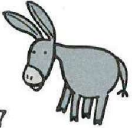
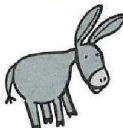


Directions: Print and cut out each card. As a family, read one verse together each day starting December 1st.
