Time Commitment:

- About 1 ½ hours on a scheduled Sunday morning, occasional training as required

On Sunday mornings, we encourage all our MCC Kids volunteers to attend one service and volunteer at the other service. We offer Kids Ministry programming at both the 9:00 and 10:30 services. Volunteers who serve at one service and attend another are welcome to have their kids stay in their classroom for both services.

Qualifications:

- Love kids and desire to teach them about Jesus through God's Word!
- Submit the 3 required background clearances: PA Criminal Record Check, PA Child Abuse Clearance, and FBI Fingerprint Clearance
- Be a follower of Jesus Christ & committed to a growing relationship with Him
- Passionate about serving in a Christ-centered ministry environment
- Willingness to participate in training as needed

Responsibilities:

- Arrive 15 minutes prior to your scheduled service.
- Wear your name tag.
- Warmly greet children as they arrive and mark them on attendance sheet.
- Free play with children, ensuring the use of only MCC Kids Ministry toys. We share space with the school and need to be mindful that we are only using toys and supplies that belong to the church.
- During lesson time, teach using the provided curriculum and supplies or assist teacher during the lesson as needed.
- Help with snack time and potty time/diaper changes (if applicable).
- Dismissal: match up the number on the child's tag with the number on the parent's tag. If the parent doesn't have a tag, they must show photo ID.
- Help clean up the room after kids have been picked up:
 - Wipe down tables and put away toys
 - Empty trash (10:30 service only)
- Complete supply request form if snacks, repairs, or supplies are needed.
- Help train new volunteers (as needed) and make them feel welcome.
- Find an appropriate substitute if you are unable to serve on your scheduled Sunday.
- Check the Slack volunteer app at least once per week to ensure you are receiving timely updates from the MCC Kids Ministry team.
