

Colossians 1:9-14

[9] And so, from the day we heard, we have not ceased to pray for you, asking that you may be filled with the knowledge of his will in all spiritual wisdom and understanding, [10] so as to walk in a manner worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing to him: bearing fruit in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God; [11] being strengthened with all power, according to his glorious might, for all endurance and patience with joy; [12] giving thanks to the Father, who has qualified you to share in the inheritance of the saints in light. The Big Idea

As we grow in the knowledge of God, our daily lives should reflect more of our identity (in Christ) and our future (with Christ).

Paul prays that the believers would grow in Christ:

- 1. Believers can know God and His will. (9)
- 2. A life of faithfulness to God honors God. (10)
- 3. God enables believers to live a life that is pleasing to Him. (11)
- 4. The "present" of the believer's life should be guided by the past and the future. (12-14)

Believers can know God and His will.

[9] And so, from the day we heard, we have not ceased to pray for you, asking that you may be filled with the knowledge of his will in all spiritual wisdom and understanding,

Notice Paul is praying that the believers in Colossae would be filled with the knowledge of God's will. Ultimately, this prayer recognizes our need for revelation from God to know Him and His will. This revelation began when they first heard "the word of truth, the gospel" (v.5). Paul's expectation is that the Colossian church, under Epaphras's ministry, will continue to listen to God's Word as it is preached. The Spirit then uses the preached Word to nurture the children of God. Believers learn about two aspects of God's will, who God is and what He is doing, through His Word. This knowledge grants believers wisdom about how they should live (a third aspect of God's will).

A life of faithfulness to God honors God.

[10] so as to walk in a manner worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing to him: bearing fruit in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God;

God revealing His will through His Word to believers is intended to have a particular result, the believers walking "in a manner worthy of the Lord." This result is pleasing because it fits with the purpose of His revelation and because it honors His calling (see Eph. 4:1).

Notice the two areas where believers can be pleasing to God: good work, knowledge. Our works are good when they bear fruit for the kingdom, not because they appear significant or righteous. Also, we all begin with a basic knowledge of God and should always be increasing in it.

God enables believers to live a life that is pleasing to Him.

[11] being <u>strengthened with all power</u>, according to his glorious might, <u>for all endurance</u> and <u>patience with joy</u>;

There are two main obstacles to believers doing God's will: ignorance of His ways and our inabilities. His revelation overcomes the first. The second obstacle is overcome by God's Spirit giving us power to do His will. Notice the strength given is guided in amount and purpose, "according to his glorious might."

The next phrase would be a warning to all who think that be equipped with God's power would lead to an easy life of no turmoil. Paul says that God's power will lead to endurance and joyful patience. Often, it is in retrospect of a difficulty that we can best discern God's good gift of enduring strength. Often, we see it clearest in others in the church.

The "present" of the believer's life should be guided by the past and the future.

[13] He has <u>delivered us from the domain of darkness</u> and <u>transferred us to the kingdom of his beloved Son</u>, [14] <u>in whom</u> we have <u>redemption</u>, the <u>forgiveness of sins</u>.

All thanks for our salvation and our growth in it should be directed to God, the Father. He created us, sent the Son for us, and gives life through the Spirit. All believers have a common future, an "inheritance of the saints." All believers have a common past, we lived in the domain of darkness (our sin) and have been moved by God's grace into Christ's kingdom. All believers have a common present, we are "in Christ" and can enjoy living in the freedom of forgiveness. Hallelujah!

Living the Christ-centered life:

How are you seeking out the knowledge of God's will?

God has revealed Himself, His purposes, and our part in His Word. Are you availing yourself of opportunities to study and mediate on the Word?

Where are you seeing the fruit of God's wisdom in your life?

Once we are saturated in the wisdom of God, His Spirit begins to use that wisdom to bear fruit in and through us. This "fruit-filled" life is the calling of every Christian. This is God's will for us.

Are you living the life of someone who has been freed by Christ? As we have been transferred into the kingdom of the Son, we are no longer under the "domain of darkness"; sin does not reign over us (Rom. 6:12). As those who are free, let us celebrate forgiveness by living the "worthy" life.
