

The Big Idea

Christ united Himself to humanity, which allows us to be united to Him and share in His life.

- Secular philosophies and externally-religious practices cannot provide the life that comes through Christ. (8-10)

Philosophies and religious practices cannot provide the life that comes through Christ.

[9] For in him the whole fullness of deity dwells bodily, [10] and you have been filled in him, who is the head of all rule and authority.

Paul warns the believers that there are deceptive teachings that they will encounter (see the warning against "persuasive arguments" in 2:4). In the whole letter, Paul seems to have two extremes of false teachings in mind. One is overtly religious, "Judaizing", in its tone. This "human tradition" teaches that avoiding certain foods and habits are keys to spirituality (2:16ff). Another false teaching is more secular, even pagan, drawing on "elemental spirits" and draws on ascetic practices that are harsh on the body but are ineffectual on a spiritual level (see 2:23) [con't next slide]

The problem with the two types of false teaching that Paul rebukes is that they are not centered on Christ. Thinking that extreme discipline can help us spiritually bases on our righteousness on our own strength or goodness. To correct this, we must understand what Christ did. He is the fullness of God now in flesh. To accept full humanity, Christ first needed to redeem the human nature (and body). Just as He redeemed His human body, when you are united to Him (v.10) then your humanity is also redeemed. He has authority over every power that would resist His redemptive work.

Apparently, the "Judaizing" group that wanted to mislead the Colossians were saying that they should be circumcised to be spiritually mature. However, Paul counters by saying that they needed a "circumcision made without hands" also called "the circumcision of Christ". In other words, they are to put on Christ (by believing in Him, not only for the salvation but for their spiritual maturity) and by doing so they will not rely on their flesh for life or feed its desires (3:5-10).

The "circumcision of Christ" is where we put away our old body of flesh by believing in Him. Because we have killed our flesh, we have a burial, which is baptism. The key is the "with Him" of our baptism. The baptism itself is not a meritorious work. Instead, as we have been united to Christ by our faith, then we bury the old human nature because it only has death (Gen. 3). Then, we are also "raised with Him" through faith, meaning that we have been given eternal life in our new humanity, which is united to Christ. Our baptism symbolizes this death and resurrection in us, while reminding us of His death and resurrection.

To be made alive with Christ by faith is only part of the gospel's power. To be resurrected is not necessarily good news if we still have to face the wrath of God (3:6). So, God also forgives us of all our trespasses. Sin is rebellion against God and it is also a breaking of His commands. So, we have a legal, "debt" of sin against us that must be removed. (con't)

How does God remove the "debt" of sin? Through the triumph of the crucifixion and resurrection, Christ pays the penalty of our sin, satisfies the wrath of God, and overcomes the power of death by resurrection. The "rulers and authorities" are any power (human or spiritual being) that would raise any claim over us as believers. We are no longer in the "domain of darkness" (1:13-14) because we belong to the Son and His kingdom. He has forgiven our sins & defeated our enemies (Rom. 6:11).

Living the Christ-centered life:

Where have you looked to improve your life or find peace?


We tend to look for life improvement and even try to find "peace" through earthly remedies that are either only temporarily (or at a surface level) helpful or based in harmful worldviews. Have you looked to Christ for help with your life? He can give true, satisfying life.

Have you identified with Christ through baptism?

Our baptism represents Christ's death for our sins and His resurrection, His victory over death. Our baptism also pictures our death to our own efforts (the old self) and our new life (eternal life) we have in Christ.

Have you had your sins forgiven?

Christ's defeat of sin and death means that He can offer to you the forgiveness of sins and eternal life. We will all be raised to stand before God. Are you prepared for that moment by having your sins forgiven in Christ?
